Schedule: The conference start in the morning of June 28 (Tuesday) and end in the afternoon of July 1 (Friday).

Goal of the Conference

The goal of the conference is contribution to exchange current research ideas, mutual communications, and possible collaborations for ring and module theory in China-Japan-Korea. Ring theorists of other country are of course very welcome to attend the conference.

Registration

Registration fee: 165,000 Korean Won (About US\$150) for each participant;

110,000 Korean Won (About US\$100) for each accompanied person.

Registration fee is paid upon arrival. We normally expect that participants will arrive on June 27 (Mon.) and depart on July 2 (Sat.) 2011. The fee covers soft drinks, banquet, local sightseeing during the conference, but not covers meals.

Abstracts

One page abstract of contributed presentations will be printed in a booklet which will be distributed to all participants. It is preferred that abstracts be prepared using a LaTex

style file. Abstracts (including titles and affiliations) should be submitted by email to one of Korea side organizers. Both tex file and pdf file are required. The deadline for receipt of all abstracts is **April 25, 2011.**

Proceedings

The proceedings of the conference will be published if sufficiently many manuscripts will be submitted timely. All papers for the proceedings will be peer reviewed to achieve a high scientific level.

Accommodation

During the conference, all participants can stay at the Dormitory of Kyung Hee University. Each room is equipped with 2 single beds / a private shower / bath room / wired LAN and AC(FCU). The accommodation fee per one room for one night is temporary 35,000 Korean Won (About US\$34).

Visas

If you need some documents for your visa we are ready to prepare them, please contact us with "one of organizers".

Climate of South Korea (June)

June is the beginning month of summer season. The temperature in daytime is about 24 degrees Celsius or about 75 degrees Fahrenheit.

Bank Services

Korean Won is the basic currency used in Korea. Money exchanges by cash or traveler's cheques can be made at any bank in towns or at airports. If you arrive by airplane, you should better first exchange some Korean money at bank in the Airport, so as to be able to pay for bus and other minor costs.

Transportations

Suwon city is located 40 km south to Seoul. The accessibility to Suwon from Seoul or other city is very convenient. From the Incheon/Seoul International Airport or Gimpo Airport(domestic) in Korea, limousine services are easily available for Suwon city.
